The prerequisites for **FALL 2018 STUDENT TEACHING** are:

The Teacher Candidate:

- must be a **SENIOR** in one of the following majors: Childhood Education, Early Childhood Education, Combined Early/Childhood Education, Extension (Math, Social Studies, English, and Foreign Language), Dual Exceptional Education/Childhood
- will have completed all required coursework, both for the college and the department, with a departmentally determined grade point average of at least 2.5/3.0 in the major and cumulatively.
- will have reviewed their Degree Works Report and may not begin their student teaching until all I/N/X grades are cleared.
- must attend the student teaching orientation and complete your student teaching paperwork as required for your program.
